
S.W.O.T. ANALYSIS



When analyzing and thinking through "Strengths and Weaknesses," concentrate on **INTERNAL** aspects of your organization. (board, staff, programs) Think more about the things that are *in your control*.

When analyzing and thinking through "Opportunities and Threats," concentrate on **EXTERNAL** aspects of your organization and mission. (funding sources, public perception, PR) Think more about the things that are <u>out of</u> your control.

How can the organization take better advantage of existing opportunities?

How can the organization address and minimize existing threats?

Positive or Negative ALIGNMENT? What are the primary 3-5 issues to be addressed that will <u>align</u> **strengths** with **opportunities** while <u>minimizing</u> **weaknesses** and **threats**?
