

The Position

The Assistant Alpine Coach/Technician helps to support the Alpine Director of Northwood School's Alpine program, working to recruit, support, and develop student-athletes involved in competitive ski racing. In addition to providing coaching and leadership on snow, this person will help team members in tuning and equipment maintenance. This position is a seasonal, exact dates to be determined, reporting to the Alpine Director and Athletic Director.

Provide leadership and direction for student-athletes and coaches:

- Work with the Director to maintain and grow the snow sports programs under the guiding principles of the school and athletic department's mission, philosophy, and core values
- Work in collaboration with the NYSEF staff
- Help organize and oversee training and race strategies and help student-athletes with equipment tuning and maintenance
- Work with student-athletes to develop a lifelong appreciation and love for the sport of Alpine skiing while helping them to grow and develop as skiers and individuals
